## Statutory Appointment Commission to Accept Applications for County Treasurer Appointment to Complete Term of Office

Huron County Treasurer, Debra McCollum, has resigned her position effective November 20, 2025, at 11:59 p.m. due to her upcoming Retirement from Huron County. Under Michigan law, MCL 168.209(2), a committee comprised of the Probate Judge, the County Clerk and the Prosecuting Attorney shall appoint a suitable person to fill the vacancy and complete the term of Office expiring December 31, 2028.

Probate Judge Julienne Ferris, County Clerk Lori Neal and Prosecuting Attorney Timothy Rutkowski are accepting applications for the position of Huron County Treasurer. Whoever is appointed will have to run as a candidate for County Treasurer in the 2028 Election Cycle and be elected if they wish to retain the position. The County Treasurer term is a four-year term, and the elections are on the same cycle as the presidential elections. The Huron County Board of Commissioners set the current salary for Treasurer for this term (2020-2024) at \$77,113 annually.

The deadline to be considered for the appointment as the Huron County Treasurer is 4:30 p.m. on December 4, 2025. Anyone who is interested must be either a current Huron County resident or agree to become a permanent resident of Huron County by the time the Oath of Office is administered.
