In response to Governor Whitmer's declared State of Emergency regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19), and to combat the spread of the disease, by administrative order of Chief Judge David B. Herrington, Huron County Courts, including the Friend of the Court and Juvenile Office, will be closed to the public on Wednesday, March 18, 2020 until 8:30 a.m., Monday, April 6, 2020. All Court staff will continue to report to work and operations will be continuing.

All jury trials during this time period have been adjourned and the March jury panels for Circuit Court and District Court have been dismissed and will not have to report. April jurors for Circuit Court, please call (989) 269-7112 for updated information about their service. April jurors for District Court, please call (989) 269-7988 for updated information about their service. Further information regarding jury duty is available at www.co.huron.mi.us.

If a litigant has questions regarding a scheduled court appearance after March 18, 2020 or other courthouse business, they should proceed as follows:

- If represented by an attorney, contact your attorney

- If you are scheduled to meet with your Probation Officer, please contact him/her by phone.
